

- Turn left (south) at The Shoe Box in Black Earth (this is 78 or County F - also called Mills St).
- Follow 78/Cty F about a half-mile through town, and turn right (west) on F/KP (also called Madison St).
- Travel about a mile until County F diverges turn left (south) on Cty F and follow to Sutcliffe Rd (it will be the second road on your right.)
- Turn onto Sutcliffe Rd and follow it (west) for just under 15 miles
- The driveway to ALNC-Black Earth is about halfway down the hill, on the right hand (north) side.
