NATURE CRAFT SEED FAIRY

Little fairies are full of wonder—and so are seeds! Fall is the perfect time to gather natural materials such as seeds, leaves, and sticks to create your own seed fairy. With a bit of glue and creativity, you can bring these natural treasures to life in the form of a charming woodland character.

This craft also offers a great opportunity to learn about how seeds travel. Pinecones simply drop to the ground, while acorns may fall or be carried off and buried by animals like squirrels. Maple seeds spin through the air on the wind, and berries such as sumac are eaten by wildlife and later deposited in new locations through their droppings.



MATERIALS

Glue, scissors, natural materials, hot glue gun (optional)

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Collect natural materials outside
- 2. Plan which pieces to use and trim or break them as needed
- 3. Carefully glue everything together (use a hot glue gun if available)
- 4. Let dry (you may need to hold pieces together during this time)
